The Trustee, Karpaga Vinayaga Educational Trust, Pudukkottai has requested the Government to grant permission to start a College of Nursing in the name and style as "Karpaga Vinayaga College of Nursing", at Chinna-Kolambakkam, Palayanor Post, Madurantakam Taluk, Kancheepuram District to conduct B.Sc. Nursing Course with an annual intake of 50 students.

2. The Director of Medical Education has forwarded the Project report of the above Trust along with the Inspection Report to the Government to consider the request of the Trust to start a College of Nursing to conduct B.Sc., Nursing Course.

3. The Government have examined the above request of the Trust in detail in the light of the Inspection Report, Project Report, and the remarks / specific recommendations of the Director of Medical Education and have satisfied that the Trust has fulfilled the norms prescribed by the Government and the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi. The Government, have therefore, decided to grant permission to the above of the Trust to start B.Sc. Nursing Course. Accordingly, the Government permit the Karpaga Vinayaga Educational Trust, Pudukkottai to start a College of Nursing in the name and style as "Karpaga Vinayaga College of Nursing", at Chinna Kolambakkam, Palayanor Post, Madurantakam Taluk, Kancheepuram District with an annual intake of 50 students, from the academic year 2010-2011, subject to the following conditions:-

- a) Admission of students shall be made as per the rules fixed by the Government from time to time.
- b) Tuition fees including special fees should be collected from the students at the same rates as prescribed by the Government from time to time. The Management should also give separate undertaking stating that no CAPITATION FEE or any other fund in the name of building fund, etc. will be collected from the students seeking admission in the proposed Nursing College.
- c) The Trust should obtain recognition / suitability/ affiliation from the Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council, Chennai, Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi and T.N. Dr. M.G.R. Medical University respectively before admitting the students.

4. The Director of Medical Education is requested to take necessary further action in this matter.
